Rules for Display

- An exhibitor may not enter more than one exhibit in any one class.
- All exhibits of honey and wax (except granulated honey) must be the production of the exhibitor for the current year.
- All comb honey must be wrapped in cellophane or Ross round containers.
- If the articles exhibited are of inferior quality, the judge will award only such prizes as they deem the exhibits merit. The judges are particularly requested to conform to this regulation.
- *In classes where there is not a minimum of three different exhibitors, exhibits will be judged with a comparable class.*
- Ribbon Decals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners. Should anyone wish an "Old Fashioned" ribbon, please ask a volunteer when you collect your exhibit.



- M-9-188 Honey, white in clear glass jars, (3 x 1 pound or 3 x 500 gram jars).
- M-9-189 Honey, golden in clear glass jars, (3 x 1 pound or 3 x 500 gram jars)
- M-9-190 Honey, amber in clear glass jars, (3 x 1 pound or 3 x 500 gram jars)
- M-9-191 Frame of comb honey (must be on stand)
- M-9-192 Bee Pollen (3 x 1 pound Jars)
- M-9-193 Honey, chunk in clear glass jar, (3 x 1 pound or 3 x 500 gram jars)
- M-9-194 Honey, granulated in clear glass jar (3 x 1 pound or 3 x 500 gram jars)
- M-9-195 Honey in comb, (3 sections)
- M-9-196 Beeswax one block, not less than 1 pound
- M-9-197 Novice class - new adult bee keeper, (up to 4 entries from any of the above 9 classes)
- M-9-198 Junior class - 18 and younger, up to 3 entries in the above 9 classes
